

CCIL Logo Use Agreement

Laboratories that are certified by CCIL may choose to place the CCIL logo on their reports and/or other communications. Before doing so, the laboratory must agree to specific conditions as noted in the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). The MOU must be signed by the supervising professional or the engineering manager of the laboratory and sent by email to Ms. G. Kermath at the CCIL certification Office, gkermath@ccil.com.

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

To: Laboratory requesting the use of the CCIL logo (enter name and full address as it appears on the Laboratory Certificate):

Your laboratory has requested to use the CCIL logo to demonstrate your certification. By placing this logo on your reports, and other forms of correspondence, you agree to adhere to the following requirements.

- The laboratory must be certified by CCIL
- The certification requirements must have been met for the context in which the logo is used.
- The use of the logo must only be used in reports or correspondence or quotations for testing work that comes under the auspices of the CCIL certification programs. In other words, the report, correspondence or quotation must include test results for one or more tests certified by CCIL.
- The use of the logo must not misrepresent the specifics of certification. It is considered a breach of ethics if a laboratory implies that they are certified for tests that are not included in their certification program.
